REFEREE PROGRAM

2013 Team Referee Point System

This document summarizes the referee support requirements for North Oxnard, AYSO Region 304, league teams during the 2013 season. Every weekend, we must fill almost 150 referee assignments. This requires the support of every team in the Region.

Every U10, U12, and U14 team must provide at least one certified referee for regular and postseason play. In addition, U16/U19 teams must provide at least one certified referee for regular season play. To be certified, individuals must pass the Basic Referee course (prior years count) complete AYSO's Safe Haven course, and the online AYSO/CDC Concussion Awareness Training. Teams are encouraged to have more than one referee. Coaches should remember that players in U12, U14 and U16/U19 can become certified referees.

POINTS: A team is awarded one point for each game assignment (U10 and above) completed by their team referee. The team shall provide a list of certified referees for their team. This list can be updated throughout the season and a referee can be on more than one team list. As shown in Table 1, team point requirements vary with the division. All U10, U12 and U14 teams are required to get three points during the pool play portion of region playoffs. A team can only be credited with a maximum of three assignments per game day.

Referees must write their team number on the back of the game card for the team to get credit for the game (i.e. **10B10** for Under-10 Boys Team 10).

The referee point totals for each team will be posted for review at the Referee Table and on the region web site. All points will be final two weeks after being posted. This "grace" period is to allow for corrections in the assignment of points.

Teams having difficulty recruiting referees should contact the referee staff for assistance. We can meet the team players and parent to explain the program and encourage participation.

Failure to complete the required points during regular season may result in the team not participating in the region playoffs. These teams **WILL NOT** advance out of pool play. Failure to provide a referee for the minimum of three games during pool play will result in the team not advancing out of pool play.
